Musicians Making A Difference (MMAD) Inc is an Australian charity that exists to change young lives through music. MMAD uses the power of music, dance & mentoring to inspire young people to make their lives remarkable.

They provide creative support to young people, (especially those who have suffered emotional abuse, neglect and disadvantage) in overcoming challenges such as homelessness, destructive patterns of behaviour, exclusion from school, family breakdown, drug and alcohol dependency, unemployment and reoffending.

BÜDDI

BUDDI stands for Byron Underage Drinking and Drug Initiative and is a CDAT (Community Drug Action Team) formed under NSW Health's Community Drug Strategies Program and is overseen by the Alcohol & Drug Foundation.

The BUDDI CDAT is a volunteer group working to find solutions to the problems associated with youth drinking and drug use in Byron Bay and provide social alternatives & education programs to young people, their parents & people working with youth.

Each year BUDDI provides youth programs, forums, youth events and also the volunteer network that helps to manages these programs. Some of the initiatives of BUDDI have included the YACROCKCAFE, formerly known as 'Friday Nights @ the YAC', which was a weekly music-based drop-in safe socialising program for teens at the Byron Youth Activities Centre.
